Mason & Hamlin Model AA (6'4") pianos are among the most sought-after used pianos. Made in Boston, vintage AA's are prized for the clarity and depth of their tone. This piano has consistent tone color and power through the entire scale, and a particularly beautiful bass. It is capable of an exceptional dynamic range. The piano is in excellent condition; the owner is a professional pianist who keeps it meticulously maintained. The piano, which dates from 1906, was completely rebuilt (including a new, hand-crafted soundboard) in 1991. Its value as assessed by a registered piano technician in April 2017 is \$15K to \$18K.
