- (2) Four (4) clear photo-copies of each manuscript. Place **name of piece, composer's age, and years studied** on manuscript. **Composer's name must NOT be on manuscript or tape.**
- (3) Two (2) good-quality CDs with composer playing composition. Place name of composition on each tape or CD (NOT name of composer), only one composition per CD. Use only music CDs (ex. Memorex Music CD-R). Alternately, teachers may submit a digital file of the music to mcconnell.piano@gmail.com, clearly labeled with the same information.

(4) Fee: \$17.00 Teacher should collect all fees from students and submit ONE check made out to NVMTA from teacher. Individual checks from students will not be accepted.
